

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT'S RESIDENTIAL FACILITY

- (a) Residential facility is permitted on annual basis for students admitted for regular programmes for the entire duration of regular academic session.
- (b) All rights of permission to avail the Residential facility are reserved with the University and can be denied to any student. No student shall be entitled to claim this facility as a matter of right.
- (c) Selection of room and seater preference will be offered on First Come First Serve basis.
- (d) The location of the residential facility, floor and room pattern are subject to change from time to time.
- (e) Residential charges mentioned in the University website are for academic session 2026 and subject to change.
- (f) Residential charges include accommodation, meals, air conditioner, electricity, power backup, housekeeping and maintenance.

Conditions of Residential facility:

- (i) Student must follow residence rules.
- (ii) The student will not be entitled to claim residential facility as a matter of right.
- (iii) University may vacate rooms for events and emergencies.
- (iv) University reserves right for inspections.
- (v) Room shifting may be done as per occupancy.
- (vi) Damage penalties apply.
- (vii) Safety precautions against infections mandatory.
- (viii) Medical expenses to be borne by student.

- (ix) Unauthorized use of electricity prohibited.
- (x) Students must maintain room cleanliness.
- (xi) Late joining may cause de-allocation.
- (xii) Campus residential facility is mandatory for students availing Scholarship.
- (xiii) Scholarship and Hostel facilities might be terminated if any student is found violating the rules and regulations of the Hostel.
- (xiv) Bringing certain electronic items like loudspeakers and sound boxes, electric kitchen wares into the hostel may be prohibited.
