

7. **3<sup>rd</sup> March 2023 :** The members of the Helping Hands Club, RGU conducted ‘Rang Barse: The Festival of Colors ’ a pre-Holi celebration centred around the diverse culture of Assam and ‘Green Holi’. This initiative by Helping Hands was centralized on this objective to raise funds for vulnerable communities, that has been materialized by acquiring essentials like stationery and books for the children belonging to these communities in the vicinity, that have been adopted by the RGU, to literacy in all communities of the society



8. **24<sup>th</sup> February 2023:** An Intra-RGU debate competition by the Royal MUN Club in association with Royal School of Commerce was organized on the topic “Rights to Abortion”. A total of 14 students across different departments took part in the competition.



9. **28<sup>th</sup> February 2023:** National Science Day was commemorated at RGU on the 28<sup>th</sup> of February 2023, by Royal School of Biosciences and Royal School of Life Sciences / Botanical society of RGU with the theme ‘Global Science for Global Well-being’. Botanical society of RGU organised various competitions like poster making, poem writing, sketching, photography, model competition etc



10. **20<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> February 2023 :** As a part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) programme, Zoology Club with Students Welfare, RGU celebrated the Wildlife Awareness Week. The wildlife awareness week included intra-RGU competitions and a wildlife mela. The competitions organized were Poster making, Photography, and Bird housing making. The wildlife mela included a photo exhibition of various animals, birds and butterflies of the North Eastern States. Students also put up stalls where they sold items which were made out of laboratory slides, endangered butterfly book-marks, and the like. As a part of Social outreach for raising funds for an Animal Shelter NGO, a small donation was made to JBF-

Just Be Friendly. JBF is a professionally managed social sector that works for the welfare of animal since 2003.

The week had been planned with various competitive events in the fields of music, dance, and drama where the 23 schools of RGU competed to emerge as the Best School in the Inter-RGU Schools Cultural Week 2023.



**16. 6<sup>th</sup> April 2023:** The Cultural procession marked the end of the RGU Varsity Cultural Week, Students from all schools participated in the cultural procession which was a competitive event.



**17. 7<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> April 2023:** RGU MUN club organized one of the biggest MUN conferences of the Assam circuit as a 3 day conference with delegates participating from the entire north east circuit. The theme of the conference was Preserving International Stability. Participating Schools/Colleges – Guwahati MVM 4, Sarla Birla Gyan Jyoti, Royal Global School, Manas Valley School, Faculty senior Secondary school, NPS, Gurukul Grammar Senior secondary school, B. Barooah College, KV Khanapara, Marias Public School, Holy Child School, SSA, DPS Khanapara, DPS Nazira, And some individual participants came from few institutions.

**18. 20<sup>th</sup> April 2023:** As a part of the club outreach programme, members of RGU MUN Club offered iftari at Ghoramara Masjid, Goramara on 20th April 2023 (Thursday).

**20. 16<sup>th</sup> March – 29<sup>th</sup> March 2023:** An intra university cricket tournament “Royal Premier League” was organized by Department of Physics, RSAPS in association with RGU sport’s committee on 16<sup>th</sup> March to 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 at the Royal Garden

- Total number of matches: 35 Matches [15 Matches (1<sup>ST</sup> Round), 7 Matches (2<sup>nd</sup> Round), 4 matches (3rd round), 5 Matches (semi- final), 1 Match ( Final), 1 Match ( women).]



**21. 27<sup>th</sup> March 2023:** The RGU Basketball Committee organized the 2<sup>nd</sup> Intra-University Basketball Tournament at the RGU Basketball court. The tournament started on 27<sup>th</sup> of March 2023 and ended on 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2023. The tournament involved 55 male players and 25 female players for a total of 80 players taking part in the competition representing 12 teams.

**22. 24<sup>th</sup> April 2023:** The club organized the RGU Intra-University Kabaddi Tournament during the Varsity Sports Week. Total 204 players participated in the tournament.

**23. 27<sup>th</sup> March 2023 – 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2023:** Badminton Club organized RGU Badminton Tournament during Varsity Sports Week. Altogether 150 players participated in the tournament

**25. 21<sup>st</sup> March 2023:** An intra university Tug-of-war competition was organized by Department of Chemistry, RSAPS in association with RGU sport's committee on 21<sup>st</sup> March to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023 at the Royal Garden. Total 510 players participated in the matches. There were 31 teams (300 participants) in Men's category, and 21 teams (210 participants) in women category.

**26. 23<sup>rd</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup> March 2023:** An intra university Arm Wrestling competition was organized as a part of the Varsity Sports Week. Total 63 students participated in the same.



**27. 7<sup>th</sup> June 2023:** Yoga Club of RGU, hosted it's inaugural event, a Yoga Competition where a total of 9 participants participated. The competition had two levels of competition- Preliminary round and the Final round. The event was a great success and garnered a lot of admiration from the participating and non-participating students.



**28. 29<sup>th</sup> May 2023:** A workshop for the students to understand the intricacies of the functioning of the Legislative Assembly was organized on 29 May 2023 in collaboration with College Students' Welfare Committee by RGU Sansad Club. 
