

## Report of Activities organized through active Clubs and other forums (2023-2024)

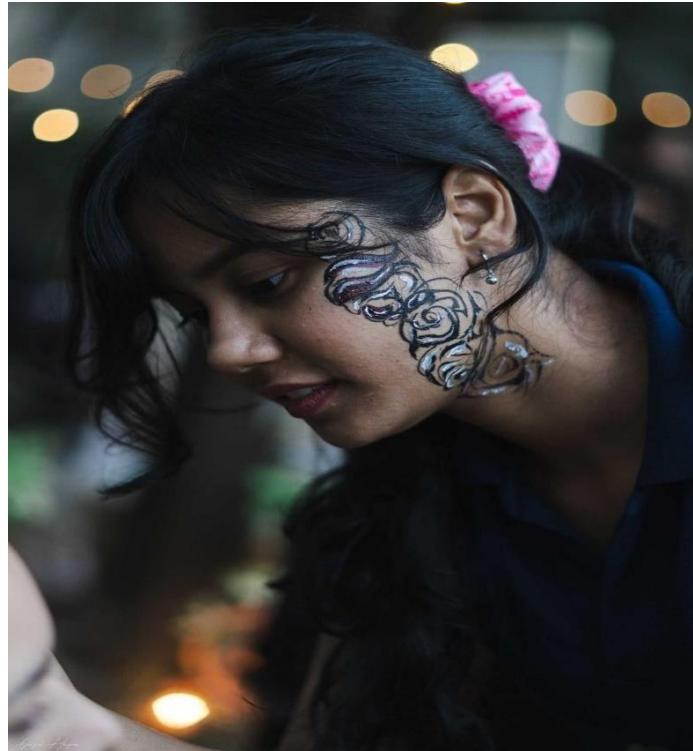
We conducted some theatre fun activities to teach them the basic essence of theatre art.
